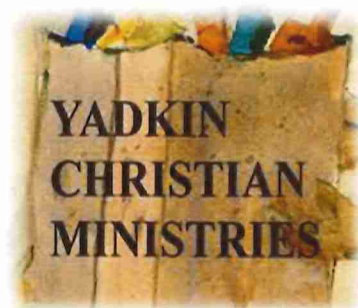

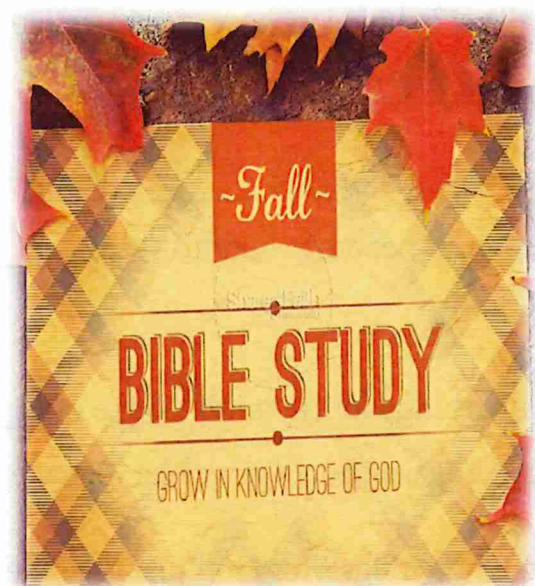
*Join us for our next Fall Bible Study!

1. Psalm 42 shows us how stormy weather can hit us personally, \_\_\_\_\_, and spiritually.

2. If doubtful thoughts \_\_\_\_\_ your vision of God for too long, then it becomes hard to see the \_\_\_\_\_ shining through a foggy faith.

3. Many things in life might shake our \_\_\_\_\_ (theology) of God, but we should never let it shake our \_\_\_\_\_.

11. Psalm 42 shows us that life always has its ups and downs, but in the midst of it all, \_\_\_\_\_ is a daily thirst that nurtures believers in the way we live, preach, pray, sing, and how to handle life’s storms, because, with \_\_\_\_\_, we never need to endure anything alone.

### ***Something To Consider:***

What does it mean to have a thirst for God? How can you develop a thirst for God? How does this compare to what Jesus said in John 4:14, “Whoever drinks the water that I will give them will never be thirsty again.”

How have you, or how would you, respond to adversity while still keeping your faith in Christ? What advice would you give someone who is going through a difficult time? In verses 5 & 11, the Psalmist said, “My Savior and my God.” Compare this to John 20:28 when Thomas replied, “My Lord and my God.” What caused both the Psalmist and Thomas to respond to God similarly?

Jesus said in Matthew 5:6, “Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be filled.” How can we stay both filled and hungry for God?

Verses 6 & 7 describe the raging seas of Mount Hermon sweeping over the Psalmist. But in verse 8 the writer turns the tides. Instead of the waters sweeping over his life, now God “pours His unfailing love upon me” (v. 8). God can transform what harms into what helps. What would you like God to transform in your life?

Life is full of ups and downs. In what ways should we remember God? How do you think remembering God helps us develop a stronger faith?

What does a life of worship mean to you?

### Financial Summary for 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter 2024

August Income: \$15,008.00

September Income: \$13,332.40

From January 2024 thru September 2024, we have received \$162,149.43 and our expenses have been \$147,883.45. **Thank you so much for supporting the General Budget of our church.**
