




Children's Church – The children will go down with Beth Woodruff to the NFH to practice for the Christmas Play today – Sunday, December 1st



Something To Consider:

In today's sermon, we have heard a lot about peace. But you may be wondering, just what is biblical peace? The word Jesus used for peace is "Shalom." This word means so much more than the absence of trials, wars, or distress. Shalom means wholeness, completeness, health, security, and even prosperity in the best sense. An Altogether Peace (Shalom) is complete and perfect peace, despite not living in a complete and perfect world. How does this understanding of Shalom help your daily life with Christ?

How might you begin to seek shalom within yourself? With another person? For the world?

People in the world walk by sight and depend on the externals, but Christians Walk by faith and depend on the eternals. The Spirit of God teaches us the Word and guides us into truth. How does the Holy Spirit help guide you?

One of the Greek words Jesus used for the Holy Spirit is *Parakletos*, meaning comforter, helper, and counselor. The Holy Spirit is the "one called to assist," and to "advocate." In Scripture, comfort does not just mean being all warm and snuggly; it means "with strength." The Holy Spirit is to advocate for you, help, counsel, teach, and strengthen you. How does the Holy Spirit help you in your daily life?

To be strong in the Lord is to be strong in the Spirit. What are some ways you can be strengthened in the Lord? How does the Holy Spirit bring you peace?

In your own words, describe the differences and similarities between peace of God and peace with God.

John Wesley preached about the difference between being an Almost Christian compared to an Altogether Christian. In your own words, what do you think is the difference between the two?
